Subject: Waterproofing Policy Change – Detail Submittal

Effective immediately, Authorized Applicators will no longer be required to submit shop drawings for waterproofing projects. Project acceptance and release of materials are no longer contingent on receipt of details. Although this policy change makes detail submittal optional, applicators should note that there may be unintended consequences associated with not doing so.

The following statement will appear on the waterproofing NOA, ANOA, and guide specs:

Sika Corp. strongly recommends that the Authorized Waterproofing Applicator submit shop drawings well prior to the job start for review by the Sika Corp. technical department to determine if the details are warrantable. If shop drawings are not submitted, the Applicator acknowledges that a Sika Corp. system waterproofing or single-source green roof warranty may not issue for the project and a membrane warranty will be provided if non-warrantable details are installed. Alternatively, changes to the details while the job is in progress may be needed which may require different products and additional training. This may result in extensive delays to the project. Correcting installed non-warrantable details to a warrantable condition, and all associated costs, are the applicators responsibility.

Applicators are encouraged to submit details for review to avoid potential warranty issues, project delays, and additional costs.
